NAME ORIGIN: Nathan Fox and Phylis Allen's Richland Hills (formerly known as Wafare Farm), is located approximately 10 miles northwest of downtown Lexington, Ky. at 3110 Old Frankfort Pike between the historic towns of Midway and Versailles. The "Home to the Kings of the Sport of Kings" stables stallions **Richter Scale**, **Andromeda's Hero** and **Star Dabbler**. Building off past successes and the knowledge gained from 25 years in the Thoroughbred business, Richland Hills has completed construction of a new 9,000 square foot stallion barn and breeding complex, a new office which includes two second story guest suites for clients, close to 10 miles of new four plank wood fencing, new paved roadways and the complete renovation of three broodmare and foal barns. The farm now consists of 155 acres located on historic in Woodford County. Richland Hills has bred, raised, sold and/or owned graded stakes winners **Blumin Affair**, **Richter Scale**, **Things Change**, **Through Flight** and **Voyagers Quest**.
