**NAME ORIGIN:** Race honors the late **Allen Bogan Jr.** (1912-1997), the legendary Dallas-Fort Worth sportswriter and Texas horseracing historian. Bogan watched his first horse race at Arlington Downs near Dallas in 1933, and, with his wife **Maxine**, they attended numerous race cards at the old Texas racetracks: Arlington Downs and Fair Park in Dallas, Epsom Downs in Houston and Alamo Downs in San Antonio. He wrote his first horse racing-related article in 1937, the same year pari-mutuel wagering was banned in Texas. As a sportswriter and editor, he worked for the *Dallas Journal*, *Dallas Times-Herald*, *Denton Record-Chronicler* and *Lewisville Leader*. In 1955, he helped launch the premier issue of *The Texas Thoroughbred*, the official magazine of the **Texas Thoroughbred Breeders' Association**, and published his popular "Morning Line" column. He was a TTBA board member from 1970-79 and was honored as an Honorary Life Member, the 1983 Man of the Year and 1995 T.I. "Pop" Harkins Award-winner (given for outstanding service to the TTBA and Texas Thoroughbred industry). It was a lifelong dream for him to see pari-mutuel horse racing return to Texas (especially North Texas). He was grateful to witness Lone Star Park's inaugural Thoroughbred season in 1997 before his death at age 84.

\* Favorite . . . t-Earned Texas-Bred Champion honors that year . . . c-Earned Lone Star Park championship honors that season . . . Run as the **Texas Legends Stakes**, 1997-98 . . . A race restricted to Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma or Texas-bred 3-year-olds was named the Allen Bogan Memorial Stakes in 1998. That race is now inactive . . . The JEH Stallion Station Stakes often serves as a prelude to the Allen Bogan and three horses have swept both races in the same season: **Mastery's Gamble** (1998), **Waverly Bell** (2000) and **Coastalota** (2002) . . . **Eagle Lake**, the 2003 winner, also won that year's Grade III WinStar Distaff Handicap . . . All in the family: A pair of half-sisters won the Allen Bogan (both out of the Island Whirl mare **Island Dance**): **Nanie's Money** in 1997 and **Nanie's Dinner** in 2001. Both won the race by at least seven lengths, returned \$8 to win as the second choice, were owned by the Courtneys and trained by **Larry Robideaux Jr.**
