NAME ORIGIN: Race honors **Assault**. Texas-bred Assault, a son of 1936 Kentucky Derby winner **Bold Venture**, earned a measure of immortality by becoming the seventh Triple Crown winner in 1946. Guiding him to his Triple Crown victories was jockey **Warren Mehrtens**. Following Assault's 1946 campaign, he was acclaimed Horse of the Year, Champion 3-year-old and Champion 3-year-old Male. Owned by **Robert J. Klegberg Jr.'s King Ranch** and trained by Texan **Max Hirsch**, homebred Assault also led the nation in earnings in 1946. Assault stepped on a sharp object that ran through the wall of his hoof as a youngster, causing him to develop a peculiar gait. His right front foot never grew to normal size and the wall was so thin that it was difficult to find enough room to anchor a nail, so shoeing him was a ticklish proposition throughout his career. Assault won 18 races and \$675,470 in 42 starts from 1945-50. In addition to the Triple Crown, he won the Wood Memorial, Dwyer Stakes, Pimlico Special, Suburban Handicap and Brooklyn Handicap (twice). Elected to the Hall of Fame in 1964, he died Sept. 1, 1971, at age 28. For more information, log onto king-ranch.com.
