\* Favorite . . . c-Earned Lone Star Park championship honors that season . . . #-Our Love, the \$1.10-1 favorite in 2005, crossed the finish line in second, but was disqualified to fifth for interference . . . Run as the City of Arlington Stakes, 1997-99 . . . Run as the Miller Lite Stakes, 2000-06 . . . The 1998 renewal was hand-timed and no splits were available . . . **Hallowed Dreams'** win in the 2001 renewal was her 23<sup>rd</sup> victory in 24 starts. The Louisiana-bred shares the modern day North American record of 16 consecutive wins with **Citation** and **Cigar** (1999 and 2000). Lone Star Park was the only racetrack she ever competed at outside her native Louisiana. In addition to the 2001 Miller Lite, she also won that year's Valid Expectations. In 2002, Hallowed Dreams finished third in the Valid Expectations in what would be her final career start . . . **Indian Breeze** shipped from Southern California to win the 2007 renewal.
