



Horsemen's Guide: ACCREDITED TEXAS-BRED PROGRAM (ATB)

Quarter Horse

If your Accredited Texas-Bred runs first, second, or third in any race (other than a stakes restricted to Accredited Texas-Breds) during the Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie Quarter Horse Meet, the owner will receive a purse supplement through the Accredited Texas-Bred (ATB) Incentive Program.

Accredited Texas-Bred Incentives will be paid by the Texas Quarter Horse Association monthly. That means Accredited Texas-Breds run for bigger purses than horses foaled in other states that are running in the same race. Races restricted to Accredited Texas-Bred horses have bigger purses than the same class of race for open company horses.

Incentive awards are distributed 50% to first, 30% to second and 20% to third. Accredited Texas-Bred owners award supplements are not paid on fourth and fifth place finishes.

Additional Accredited Texas-Bred awards for breeders and stallion owners are paid monthly through the office of the Texas Quarter Horse Association.
