NAME ORIGIN: Race honors the graded stakes winning mare **Cinemine**, the first horse ever purchased by **Diane and Ted Connell's Nolan Creek Farm** of Kileen, Texas. Cinemine, a Kentucky-bred daughter of **Mining** out of the **Mt. Livermore** mare **Texas Cinema**, earned \$506,681 between 1997-2000 while under the care of trainer **Larry Robideaux Jr.** In 10 starts at Lone Star Park, she prevailed in six, including a record-equaling five Lone Star Park stakes events: the Grapevine Stakes (now known as the Richland Hills Stakes) and Lone Star Oaks in 1998, the City of Arlington Stakes (Nevill/Kyocera Stakes) in 1999 and Wild Flower Stakes (Valid Expectations Stakes) in 2000. In turn for her stellar local performances, she was crowned Lone Star Park's Champion 3-year-old Female in 1998 and Champion Older Female in 2000. In her two starts during the 2000 meet, she set track records (since broken) for 5 ½ furlongs (1:02.85) and six furlongs (1:08.40). The latter came while winning the 2000 Wild Flower. Eight of Cinemine's 12 career victories came in stakes events, including the Grade III Thoroughbred Club of America Stakes at Keeneland in 1999. Following the final race of her 29-race career in 2000, she was privately purchased as a broodmare by **WinStar Farm** near Versailles, Ky. In 2003, Cinemine foaled **Outrageous Limit**, a **Tiznow** colt who broke his maiden at Santa Anita in 2006 and finished second in the \$50,000 Jim Coleman Province Handicap at Hastings Park in his subsequent start.
