NAME ORIGIN: Race is sponsored by **Jim and Marilyn Helzer's JEH Stallion Station**, located in Pilot Point, Texas (they also sponsored the Park Cities Stakes in 1999-2000, which is now known as the Stonerside Stakes). It is a breeding farm that stands nine stallions: **Corona For Me, Feature Mr Jess, La Jollaroid, Latest Version, Leaving Memories, Mighty Invictus, This Candy Is Red Hot, This Snow Is Royal and Tres Seis**. There also is a JEH Stallion Station in New Mexico. The Helzers established JEH Stallion Station in 1994 at the former site of Phillips Ranch in Frisco, Texas. In 1998 JEH moved to its present location in Pilot Point, Texas. One of the Southwest's leading equine facilities consists of a 50-stall main barn; eight-stall stallion barn; 150 individual paddocks with sheds for wet mares; 176 individual covered paddocks for dry mares; a heated foaling barn; a breeding barn with a state-of-the-art vet laboratory; a complete isolation facility; 15 pastures ranging from five to 15 acres; and 24-hour security and horse surveillance. **Andrew Gardiner** is the ranch manager and **Dr. Cole Sciba** is the attending veterinarian. The other is the \$50,000 Allen Bogan Jr. Memorial Stakes (one mile on July 12). **Mastery's Gamble** (1998), **Waverly Bell** (2000) and **Coastalota** (2002) successfully swept both races.
