

**Attention Horsemen**  
**Updated Shipping Requirements**  
**Effective Immediately**

Horses originating from any premise under quarantine for Equine Piroplasmiasis shall not enter Lone Star Park.

Horse entering from any part of Kleburg County or adjacent counties (Nueces, Jim Wells, Brooks and Kenedy) not under quarantine may enter Lone Star Park so long as accompanied by a certificate of Veterinary Inspection prepared and signed by an accredited veterinarian within fourteen (14) days and these horse will be required to stable in Barn E-7 only while at Lone Star Park.

Though not required at this time, Lone Star Park recommends that all horses shipping in regardless of origin be inspected by a veterinarian for ticks upon arrival.
