NAME ORIGIN: Bob and Leland Ackerley of the Ackerley Brothers Farm have led the charge to sponsor the race since 2001. They stand Valid Expectations in partnership at Will Farish's Lane's End Texas in Hempstead, Texas for \$17,500 Live Foal. Other stallions at Lane's End Texas are Dove Hunt, Midway Road, Open Forum, Parade Ground and Truluck. Valid Expectations, winner of the Grade III Derby Trial and Grade III Sport Page Handicap as a 3-year-old in 1996, won 12 of 27 starts, including seven stakes races, and earned \$596,092. He was Lone Star Park's all-time leading trainer Steve Asmussen's first "big horse". By Valid Appeal out of Mepache, he's a brother to Little Sister, Miss Valid Pache, Little Expectations and Babyexpectations. Valid Expectations was the leading sire in Texas in 2005 and second to Running Stag in 2006.
