The gelding unexpectedly died in November, 1999 from complications while undergoing knee surgery . . . **Leo's Last Hurray**, the 2002 winner, was the highest earning Texas-bred in 2002 with \$326,848 and earned Texas Horse of the Year and Texas Champion 2-Year-Old Colt/Gelding honors. He was first or second in each of his seven starts that year . . . 2006 runner-up **Datrick** won the Grade III Kentucky Breeders' Cup at Churchill Downs prior to his start in the TTA Sales Futurity.
