The 1999 renewal was the first graded Thoroughbred stakes race in Texas (a Grade III) . . . **Skip Away**, third in the inaugural Texas Mile, was crowned Champion Older Male in 1997 and was honored as Horse of the Year in 1998 . . . **Real Quiet**, runner-up in the 1999 Texas Mile, was the first Kentucky Derby winner to race in Texas . . . The Texas Mile is one of two Grade III events on the main track for older horses. The other is the \$400,000 Lone Star Park Handicap (1 1/16 miles on Monday, May 26). **Dixie Dot Com**, the 2001 winner, is the only horse to successfully complete the Texas Mile-Lone Star Park Handicap double, known as "The Texas Two Step." . . . Run the same day as the Lone Star Derby, 1997-2000.
