FILLY SENSATION RACHEL ALEXANDRA TO RUN SATURDAY, SEPT. 5 AT SARATOGA AGAINST OLDER MALES IN WOODWARD STAKES

Jess Jackson's Rachel Alexandra, trained by Lone Star Park's perennial leading trainer Steve Asmussen, will try to become the first filly or mare in history to win the Grade 1, \$750,000 Woodward Stakes this Saturday at Saratoga Racecourse. The 3 YO filly, who has won her last eight races, including four consecutive Grade 1s, is scheduled to face a field of seven older males in the 56th running of the race.

Among her opponents are 2009 Lone Star Park Handicap winner It's a Bird, Whitney Hcp. winner Bullsbay, and Stephen Foster Hcp. winner Macho Again.
