In addition to his wins, the Louisiana-bred finished third in 1998, second in '99 and sixth in '01 . . . **Spiritbound**, the 1998 winner, made his 50th and final career start in the 1999 renewal; he finished 3rd at \$5.10-1 . . . **Prankster** invaded from Kentucky to win the 1999 renewal . . . **Nuclear Debate** shipped from Southern California to win the 2002 edition . . . **Mighty Beau** shipped from Kentucky to win in 2004.
