NAME ORIGIN: The Pan Zareta Division honors of the greatest race mares of all-time. Foaled in 1910, **Pan Zareta** was bred in Texas and named for the daughter of an official of the city of Juarez. She spent most of her racing career (1912-17) in the Midwest (Texas, Montana, Idaho, Canada, Kentucky, Louisiana and Arkansas) and Mexico participating in races of six furlongs or less. Most of these races had purses of \$300. Still, the money grew quickly because Pan Zareta was a winner. No mare had ever won so many races - 76. She also consistently carried higher weights than other mares. In 28 of her 151 races, she carried 130 pounds or more; in seven of her contests she carried 140 pounds or more. Pan Zareta's winning style continued when she was brought to New York at age seven. She broke Jamaica's record for 5 ½ furlongs and won carrying 135, 137 and 140 pounds. During her career, Pan Zareta set or equaled 11 track records. In her career, Pan Zareta won 76 of 151 races with 31 seconds, 21 thirds and earnings of \$39,082 for owners **J.F. Newman** (her breeder), **E.T. Colton** and **Joe Marrone**. She was retired for breeding in 1918 and failed to get in foal. She was brought to Fair Grounds for a return to racing, but contracted pneumonia and died on Christmas Day, 1918 at age 8. She was buried in the track's infield. In 1972, Pan Zareta was voted into the National Racing Hall of Fame.
