NAME ORIGIN: Race honors the noted late owner and breeder **Carter McGregor Jr.** from Wichita Falls, Texas. A former World War II pilot, McGregor was a president of the Texas Thoroughbred Breeders' Association and the first president of the Texas HBPA. He bred and raced numerous stakes winners, including **Dancing Dervish**, who ranked among the best Texas-based stallions for years.
