COGGINS AND HEALTH CERTIFICATES

To be admitted on to an association's grounds, a horse must have:

- 1. A negative test for equine infections anemia conducted in accordance with rules of the Texas Animal Health Commission in the twelve-month period preceding the horse's arrival. It is now criminal offense to transfer ownership of a horse (by Bill of Sale or Claim) without a current negative Coggins.
- 2. A health certificate issued in the 30-day period preceding horse's arrival.
