PADDOCK SCHOOLING

Horse may school in the paddock after the track closes for training until noon except on days when we have day racing (post time before 5 pm). Please note that the cross traffic in the tunnel is not stopped at this time so use extra caution when approaching the automatic doors.

Variations from this schedule will be considered but must be approved to coordinate the safety of employees and patrons in and around the paddock.

In order to school your horse during the races you must call the racing office and reserve a spot in a particular race. Schooling will not be allowed during stakes or two year old races.

When schooling during the races your horse must go to the holding barn with the rest of the horses for that race. Your horse should be prepared as if he was going to race. Your horse will follow the field up to the paddock and then remain in the paddock during the running of the race. After the race your horse will go back to the stable area with the rest of the horses from that race.
