SHOE POLICY

Under TXRC Section 313.426

- (a) A Thoroughbred is ineligible to start in a race when it has shoes (racing plates) that have toe grabs with a height greater than two millimeters (0.07874 inches), bends, jar chalks, stickers or any other traction device on the front hooves.
- (b) A Quarter Horse, Paint Horse, or Appaloosa is ineligible to start in a race when it has shoes (racing plates) that have toe grabs with a height greater than four millimeters (0.15748 inches), bends, jar chalks, stickers, or other traction device on the front hooves.

All shoes will be inspected upon arrival in the paddock and violators will be scratched and are subject to be fined.
