Lone Star Park Piroplasmosis Policy

A negative Piroplasmosis cElisa test for Theileria equi that has been performed within the last year is required for all horses entering the stable area except for Thoroughbreds.

Piroplasmosis test results will now be required to be turned into the racing office with the foal papers and coggins in order to receive a date and to race for all breds except Thoroughbreds.

This will enable us to produce lists to provide the stable gate and the Texas Animal Health Commission to ensure compliance.

We do still recommend testing for Babesia caballi also due to the fact that many other states still require this for entry. And though the test is not required, any horse testing positive for babesia caballi is not permitted in the stable area.

And as usual you must also provide the stable gate a negative Coggins test within the past twelve months and have a valid health certificate dated within 30 days when entering the stable area.
