
SHOE RULES

Under TXRC Section 313.426 (a) A Thoroughbred or Arabian is ineligible to start in a race when it has shoes (racing plates) that have toe grabs with a height greater than two millimeters (0.07874 inches), bends, jar chinks, stickers or any other traction device on the front hooves.

(b) A Quarter Horse, Paint Horse or Appaloosa is ineligible to start in a race when it has shoes (racing plates) that have toe grabs with a height greater than four millimeters (0.15748 inches), bends, jar chinks, stickers or any other traction device on the front hooves.

On the turf course, the only shoes allowed are queen xt and silver queen xt. All shoes will be inspected upon arrival in the paddock and violators will be scratched and are subject to be fined.
