ACCREDITED TEXAS-BRED PROGRAM

To encourage the breeding of horses in this state, any accredited Texas-Bred horse finishing first, second or third in any race in Texas (other than a stakes race restricted to Accredited Texas-Breds) may be eligible for Owner, Breeder and/or Stallion Awards through the ATB Incentive Program.

Funding for awards is derived from breakage and 1% of all multiple wagers at each racetrack, with each racetrack generating awards funds only for the horses racing at that track. From the total generated, award funds are separated into categories for eligible owners (40%), breeders (40%) and stallion owners (20%). Additionally, the first 25% of all awards generated is set aside for Owner Bonus Awards, paid to owners of ATB horses finishing first, second or third in open company races. The Owner Bonus is in addition to regular ATB Owner Awards.

All ATB Incentive Program awards – owner bonus, owner, breeder and stallion owner will be paid by the Texas Thoroughbred Association approximately four weeks after the Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie meet has ended.

NOTE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The intent of the racetrack condition book preamble is to provide up-to-date information on requirements for racetracks and occupational licensees. Weekly visual inspections are required of racetracks during live racing and are to be reported to the Commission via email to info@txrc.texas.gov. Daily visual inspections are strongly encouraged. Any issues regarding the safety, integrity or welfare of racing participants should be immediately reported to the Commission.

If there is any conflict with the Texas Racing Act or the Texas Rules of Racing and racetrack house rules or race sponsor rules, the Texas Racing Act and Texas Rules of Racing prevail.

LICENSING

******Multiple Year Licenses are available for the following:
Jockeys, Owners, Trainers. and Veterinarians.***

Prior to entering a horse into a race, all participants (trainers, owners, and those in their employ that require a license to perform their duties) should have a current Texas Racing Commission license.

TRAINERS:

1. All Trainers shall be licensed prior to the entry procedure and are encouraged to update their license before reserving a stall for a live race meet or training facility works.
2. It is the trainer's responsibility to keep the Texas Racing Commission licensing office current on their owners' and employees' status. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action by the stewards.
3. Whenever a trainer terminates an employee, the licensing office should be notified, and their badge returned. The license badge may be returned to the licensee when they are employed by another licensed trainer.

OWNERS:

1. All Owners, as listed on the horse's registration papers, shall be licensed prior to the entry of that horse.
2. Owners' license will not be issued unless a licensed trainer is named on their application.
3. All owners who lease horses for racing purposes are responsible for licensing both the Lessee and Lessor.
4. If the owner is not an individual, each partner who has an ownership interest of five percent (5%) or more must be licensed by the Texas Racing Commission.
5. A person may not be licensed as an owner if the person is not the owner of record of a properly registered race animal which the person intends to race in Texas which is in the care of a trainer licensed by the Texas Racing Commission.

NOTE: All Owners, Trainers, and Lessees must be licensed before the race day in which their horse will participate, including being licensed on the date of entry. Texas Racing Commission licensing staff will be available during live race **events** but cannot guarantee a license issuance or renewal will occur if previous application steps were not met (digital fingerprints, evaluation of possible disqualifiers, etc.). LICENSE FINGERPRINT INFORMATION

-Fingerprints are required for all licensees who do not have fingerprints on file with the Texas Racing Commission.

-Fingerprints for new applications must be attained prior to applying with the Texas Racing Commission.

All licensing application must have a copy of the fingerprint receipt, before the Texas Racing Commission will process the application.

SPECIMEN TESTING

The Texas Racing Commission tests specimens include, but are not limited to serum, urine, and hair. All breeds will be subject to hair testing at random or for cause, as determined by the Texas Racing Commission. The Texas Racing Commission has secured a contract with the Equine Analytical Chemistry Laboratory (EACL) for accomplishing the testing of equine samples. The agency maintains discretion for using any accredited laboratory necessary to accomplish proper analysis, including split samples.

STATE VETERINARY MONITORING OF MORNING TRAINING

State veterinarians have authority to monitor morning training and identify lame horses on the training track. Horses on the training track will be subject to the same evaluation protocol as horses during pre-race exams. Horses must jog past the state veterinarian for 8-10 strides when exiting the training track after exercise. Exercise riders can be asked to jog a questionable horse on the walking path after exercise to confirm a lameness seen on the track. Horses lame after morning training will be identified and placed on the Vet List if appropriate. Any horse that works out for an official time can have blood samples collected post workout.

WORKOUTS AND FIRST-TIME STARTERS

First time starters must have two published works within 90 days, one being within 60 days. All first-time starters must be approved by a Licensed Starter for proficiency in the starting gate within 90 days of the race entered.

VETERINARIAN'S EXAMS

Pre-race veterinarian examinations for horses stabled on the grounds will be conducted from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. Anyone shipping horses into barns other than the Receiving Barn, must notify the Commission Veterinarians of such barn and stall location. The horse's legs must be unwrapped and clean for this examination. For further information please call the State Veterinarian.

All Vet List timed workouts or exams required for race entry must be scheduled 2-3 days in advance by contacting the Chief State Veterinarian, Dr. Steve Bond at (512)529-1546.

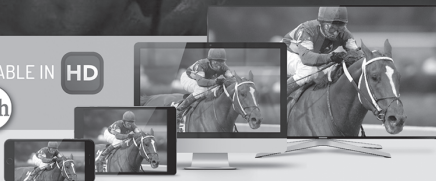

Lip Chains

Trainers will wrap all lip chains with leather or heavy tape wrap. Any part of the chain that contacts the horse's gums or corners of the mouth cannot be bare chain. Lip chains must be attached to provide some relief to the horse from constant chain pressure.

Ship-in Horses, Lasix & Pre-Race Exams

Any horse(s) shipping into a barn, other than the receiving barn, must notify the TXRC State Vet of the barn location prior to the start of pre-race exams at 9:00 am. Trainers are responsible for securing a veterinarian to administer timely Lasix for their horses. Please contact the test barn for details.

ENTRY SCHEDULE

Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie will be on a 7 Day entry schedule. All riders must be named at entry time. The Racing Office will open at 8:00 am on entry days and entries will close at 10:30 am. Scratch time will be 10:00 am on the day of the scheduled races. You can view the draws on Zoom. ID # 446-466-4508, PIN # 779578. There is also a link at the bottom of the Horsemen's Information section of our web site.

ELIGIBILITY

No entries will be accepted for the following:

- A horse that is more than 12 years of age may not start in a pari-mutuel race in this state unless:
 - (a) The horse has finished first, second or third in an officially sanctioned race during the 12 month period preceding the race in which the horse is to start; or
 - (b) Upon due consideration of the horse's past performance, the board of stewards has given specific authorization for the horse to start.
 - Entries will not be accepted for horses that are deemed to be non competitive or unfit to race by the Racing Secretary, Stewards or State Veterinarian.
 - Quarter horse maidens six years old or older.
 - Arabian horses finishing more than 35 lengths behind in two consecutive races will be placed on the Racing Secretary's List for a minimum of 14 days beginning with the day after their race. They will require two timed workouts before they can reenter. Both workouts must be done before an entry will be accepted.

COGGINS AND HEALTH CERTIFICATES

To be admitted on to Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie's grounds, a horse must have:

1. A negative test for equine infectious anemia conducted in accordance with rules of the Texas Animal Health Commission in the 180 day period preceding the horse's arrival. It is a criminal offense to transfer ownership of a horse (by Bill of Sale or Claim) without a current negative Coggins. To keep Coggins test from expiring during the meeting, they MUST be dated after January 15, 2026.
 2. A health certificate issued in the 30-day period preceding horse's arrival.
 3. We also continue to require that all horses admitted to the stable area to have a current (within 180 days) FDA approved EHV-1 vaccine or EHV-1 booster. Vaccine information must be noted on the health certificate for admittance to Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie's grounds.
 4. It is mandatory for all horses except thoroughbreds to have a negative Piroplasmosis cElisa test for Theileria equi that has been performed in the last year.

SHOE RULES

Under TXRC Section 313.426 (a) A Thoroughbred or Arabian is ineligible to start in a race when it has shoes (racing plates) that have toe grabs with a height greater than two millimeters (0.07874 inches), bends, jar chinks, stickers or any other traction device on the front hooves.

(b) A Quarter Horse, Paint Horse or Appaloosa is ineligible to start in a race when it has shoes (racing plates) that have toe grabs with a height greater than four millimeters (0.15748 inches), bends, jar chinks, stickers or any other traction device on the front hooves.

On the turf course, the only shoes allowed are queen xt and silver queen xt.

All shoes will be inspected upon arrival in the paddock and violators will be scratched and are subject to be fined.

ENTRY RULES

1. Racing Office will open for entries at 8:00 am. Entries close at 10:30 am. No entries are accepted on overfilled races after closing time of entries. Though an entry may be taken as an AE if space allows.
2. Prior to entering a horse, all participants must have a current Texas Racing Commission license.
3. A horse must be tattooed or micro chipped, and the registration papers or digital papers along with a current negative Coggins must be on file in the Racing Secretary's office not later than one hour before post time for the first race of that day.
4. A blinker change must be approved by the starter and reported at time of entry.
5. Maidens entering in winner's race must declare at time of entry that the horse is a maiden.
6. Owners and Trainers must be careful to claim allowances and preference date at time of entry. This is the sole responsibility of the person making the entry.
7. Horses not entitled to the first allowance in a race are not entitled to the second and, if not to the second, then to any subsequent allowances.
8. No horse shall be entered in more than one race on any race day, unless at least one of the races is a stake race. If such an entry does happen to cause a race to overfill and lead to an exclusion, the horse must remain in the body of the overfilled race. In the event both races overfill, the decision must be made prior to closing of entries.
9. When a person makes a coupled entry, the entry with the better date will be preferred in an overnight race. If they have the same date, the trainer must make first and second choice.
10. All races, overnights and stakes, will be drawn with up to two AEs.
11. In Today horses must have the permission of the racing secretary to be enter in another race.

HOTWALKERS

RECEIVING BARN

All horses shipping in to race must stable in the receiving barn. Horses shipping in to Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie to work or shipping earlier than their scheduled race day must contact the Stall Superintendent before shipping. All horses shipping in to work must vacate the receiving barn by 11:00 am.

SCRATCH POLICY

All horses scratched at Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie may only be made by permission of the stewards. We ask that scratches be made by 10:30 am on race day to allow AEs to draw in.

WORKOUTS AND FIRST-TIME STARTERS

If a horse has not started in the **60-day period** preceding a race, the horse must have **one published workout** to be eligible to start in that race.

If a horse is a **first-time starter**, the horse must have **two published workouts, one of which must be from the starting gate within 90 days and one must be within the last 60 days of the race entered**, in order to be eligible to start in a race. The first-time starter must also be approved from the starting gate by an approved facility for proficiency in the starting gate. Lone Star Park's starter reserves the right to refuse an approval from another facility.

First time starters around the turn must be approved by the clocker prior to entering in a one turn race and have a **minimum 660 yard** published workout within the last **60 days**. Trainers must notify the clocker prior to working a horse for turn approval.

Any horse that has not started within the last 365 days must have 2 published workouts within 60 days preceding the race and an approved letter from the attending veterinarian to be eligible to run.

All horses working at Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie must be identified by name (breeding if unnamed), type of workout and distance to the Gap Attendant. Failure to report this information will result in referral to the stewards. Foal certificates must be on file in the Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie Racing Office before a horse will receive an official work.

PREFERENCE SYSTEM

1. Preference date will not be assigned until the horse's papers and current negative Coggins tests are on file in the Racing Office. To keep Coggins tests from expiring during race meet they must be dated on or after **January 15, 2026**. According to TXRC rule 319.110 a negative coggins is required to be within 180 days to remain current.
2. In any overnight race, regardless of conditions, an 'in today' horse is ALWAYS least preferred and the second part of an entry (by owner or trainer) cannot enter to the exclusion of a single interest. Though the second part of an entry is preferred over an 'in today' horse.
3. Condition eligibility preference applies to all races except stakes. In optional allowance/claiming races, horses eligible to the allowance condition will have first preference. Condition eligibility supersedes dates and 'second part of an entry' but not an 'in today' horse.
4. Preference dates will not supersede the conditions of a race.
5. All registration certificates including received on or before **Tuesday, April 7, 2026** will receive a zero, which is the lowest possible date. A horse keeps his zero until he runs, scratches, or the papers are removed from the Office (unless, for just cause - tattoo, corrections, etc.) the Racing Secretary may determine the status of the preference date established.
6. All registration certificates including digital certificates received after **Tuesday, April 7, 2026** through **Thursday, April 16, 2026** will receive a preference date of **E1**. Registration certificates received after **Thursday, April 16, 2026** will receive an "E" date corresponding to the race day that the certificates are submitted to the Racing Office. Certificates that are submitted to Racing Office on a non race day will be assigned the next upcoming race day date.
7. Horses that run will receive a running "R" date of the same day and lose any date previously held. This excludes Stakes and Trials in which they will retain their previous date.
8. Horses which scratch or are scratched will receive a scratch "S" date for the day that they were entered to run.
9. Horses that remain in a race that is transferred to the main track from the turf course will revert back to their previous date.
10. All horses placed on the Steward's, Starter's or Veterinarian's lists will be posted on the bulletin board. They will not be permitted to enter until they have been approved to start. A horse which raced before going on a list will keep its "R" date. Horses which were scratched will be given an "S" date of the day the horse comes off the list.
11. Entry "E" dates will have preference over a running "R" dates of the same date. Entry "E" dates and running "R" dates will have preference over scratch "S" dates of the same date.
12. In no way does claiming, ownership transfer or trainer transfer of a horse affect the preference date. It is the responsibility of the person making an entry to claim preference at time of entry. Preference dates are set at the time of entry. Any changes, omissions, discrepancies, errors, etc. must be lodged prior to the drawing of entries for that day.
13. Any quarter horse maiden with a zero date that is excluded at the counter from a "Maiden Allowance" race will receive a "01" date. Any maiden with a "01" date that is excluded at the counter will receive a "02" date and so on. In any Maiden Allowance" races a "01" will be preferred over a "0" and a "02" will be preferred over a "01" and so on. The dates are only valid in "Maiden Allowance" races. In all other race types, the date will revert back to the "0" date.
14. **Registration certificates that are not tattooed or digital certificates that are not verified will not receive a preference date.**
15. Also eligibles will be drawn in all races where the field size and the tote board permit.
16. In all matters, the Steward's ruling is final.

NAMING OF JOCKEYS

- Each horse to be drawn into the race must have its jockey named by the time established by the Racing Secretary for the draw of post positions and before the overnight is printed.
- It is the trainer's responsibility to name a jockey before the drawing of the race. Should a jockey remain unnamed at the time of the drawing of entries, the Stewards or their appointee shall select one. No jockey, once named, shall be changed except for good cause by the Stewards.

HORSEMEN'S BOOKKEEPING

In the State of the Texas the horsemen's bookkeeping system is centralized by the Texas Horsemen's Partnership, in order to better serve the horsemen running at the numerous tracks throughout the state. It is now similar to branch banking. This means that any necessary account maintenance can be done from any racetrack running a live meet in the state and through the Texas Horsemen's Partnership main office in Austin year round.

Prior to starting a race an owner must have on deposit with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper the amount required to cover all costs incurred in starting that horse.

Prior to putting in a claim for a horse the owner or their Designated Representative must insure that all funds incurred with claiming a horse are on deposit in said account.

All places shall be paid in overnight races. Sixth through last place shall receive \$100.

First through fifth place purse distribution shall be paid the following percentages after sixth through last place is paid out of the total purse:

First – 60%, Second – 20%, Third – 11%, Fourth – 6% and Fifth – 3%

All jockey mount fees must be paid prior to the running of a race.

ALSO ELIGIBLE (AE) & MAIN TRACK ONLY (MTO)

1. Also eligibles will be drawn in all races where the field size and the tote board permit.
 2. In a turf race, AEs and MTOs will be equally split and AEs will be drawn first and MTOs will follow.
 3. Trainers, at time of entry, must designate turf or MTO entry which will be noted on the overnight and program for that day.
 4. MTO entries will be preferred over other MTO entries at time of draw by the established preference date system.
 5. If races remain on the turf at scratch time, all MTO horses will be scratched and will get their dates back.
 6. MTO horses that draw into a race that is transferred to the main track will receive a "R" date for that race day.
 7. When a turf race is called off the turf prior to scratch time, MTO horses will be considered starters unless there are not sufficient scratches to allow starting space in the starting gate at the designated.

STABLE RULES

Lone Star Park Security will inspect and enforce the following:

1. Please remember that all manure must be placed in the bins provided for this purpose. Lone Star Park employees will remove only the manure placed in the bins. It is the responsibility of each trainer and his employees to see that the excess manure around the bins is raked up and placed inside the bins for proper disposal.
2. Dogs are not allowed in the stable area.
3. Only Lone Star Park rental hotwalkers are permitted.
4. All hoses located in the stable area must have an automatic shut-off nozzle and shall be turned off when not in use.
5. All washing machines must be located near or inside wash racks and empty into wash rack drains. (EPA Regulation)
6. All horse bathing with soaps or detergents must be done in the wash racks. (EPA Reg.)
7. Trainers will be responsible for Universal Waste left at their barns such as batteries, tires, paints, oils or any chemicals that are considered harmful to the environment.
8. Ponies are not allowed in the paddock.
9. Smoking is not permitted in the barns.
10. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the stable area.
11. Firearms or fireworks are not permitted in the stable area.
12. All shavings must be bagged except for your initial bedding.
13. All licensees must wear their badge in the stable area, test barn, holding barn & paddock.
14. Maintenance work orders must be filled out & signed by Trainers or Assistant Trainers. They will be addressed on a daily basis. For emergencies and after hours call x 5184.

MANURE HANDLING PROCEDURES

Due to federal and state regulations, serious and monetarily substantial regulatory penalties can be imposed on Lone Star Park for allowing the improper handling of manure and bedding materials on the property. Every due diligence effort and precaution must be employed to prevent the contamination of ground water and migration of manure effluence into the storm drains.

- Lone Star Park is responsible for providing sufficient designated manure/bedding containers for each barn.
- It is the trainer's and his employee's responsibility to ensure that all manure and bedding is properly disposed of in the designated containers at each barn at all times.
- Trainers and their employees are also responsible to ensure that any manure and/or bedding dropped from the wheel barrels between the barn and the designated containers is subsequently picked up and placed in the designated containers.
- If the designated containers reach their capacity, trainers must call the stall superintendent at (972)237-5058 to request an additional container. Do not overfill the containers.
- Trainers and their employees are responsible for assuring that all trash, bottles and cans, etc. are properly placed in the trash containers provided at the ends of each barn and not in the designated manure containers.
- Trainers and their employees are responsible for picking up and properly disposing of all manure deposited by their horses while on the hotwalkers. No bedding materials are permitted around the hotwalkers.
- Additionally horses must be washed only in the designated horse wash racks inside each barn.
- And all washing machines must drain into the wash rack drains inside the barn.

DORMITORY ROOMS

Dormitory rooms will be assigned to trainers based on the number of stalls they have been assigned. The trainer is required to pay \$100 non refundable fee for each room allotted. \$35 key deposit and keys must be returned and rooms maintained to the satisfaction of Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie management, if not, additional charges may apply. The stall superintendent will assign dormitory rooms.

MEDICATION

No prohibited drug, chemical, or other substance may be administered to an animal within the 24-hour period before the post time for the race in which the animal is entered.

Phenylbutazone: Phenylbutazone (Bute) is the only approved anti-inflammatory drug, which may be present in the body of a horse while participating in a race. The test level of Bute shall not exceed 0.3 micrograms (mg) per milliliter (ml) in plasma.

BLEEDER PROGRAM - §319.111. Bleeders and Furosemide Program

- (a) Diagnosis of EIPH.** (1) A bleeder is a horse that experiences Exercise Induced Pulmonary Hemorrhage (EIPH). Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, the medical diagnosis of EIPH may be made only by a commission veterinarian or a veterinarian currently licensed by the Commission. If the first EIPH event experienced by a horse occurs in another pari-mutuel racing jurisdiction, certification of the horse as a bleeder by that foreign jurisdiction will also constitute a first report of a diagnosed EIPH event for purposes of this section. A veterinarian who diagnoses an EIPH event in a horse participating in pari-mutuel racing in this state shall report the event to the commission veterinarian in a format prescribed by the executive director. On receipt of the first report of a diagnosed EIPH event for a horse, the commission veterinarian shall certify the horse as a bleeder.
- (2) A trainer may request that a commission veterinarian reconsider the commission veterinarian's diagnosis of an EIPH event by presenting the horse for re-examination within four hours of the initial diagnosis, or within one hour after a performance's last race, whichever occurs sooner. To receive reconsideration, the trainer must present the horse to the commission veterinarian for endoscopic examination as performed by a commission-licensed veterinarian.
- (b) Admission to Furosemide Program.** (1) A trainer may admit a horse to the furosemide program by stating at time of entry that the horse will compete with furosemide. (2) A horse that competed with furosemide in its most recent start out-of-state must compete on furosemide in Texas unless withdrawn from the furosemide program at time of entry. (3) The voluntary administration of furosemide without an external bleeding incident shall not subject the horse to an initial period of ineligibility under subsection (g) of this section. (c) Administration of Furosemide. Furosemide shall be administered to a horse in the furosemide program not later than four hours before the published post time for the race the horse is entered to run. The furosemide must be administered intravenously by a veterinarian licensed by the Commission. The executive director shall periodically publish the permissible blood levels of furosemide in post-race specimens and shall post the levels at each licensed racetrack.
- (d) Requirement to Use Furosemide.** A horse in the furosemide program in Texas must compete with furosemide until withdrawn from the program.
- (e) Withdrawal from Furosemide Program.** (1) To withdraw a horse from the furosemide program, the trainer must state his/her intention to race the horse without furosemide at the time of entry. (2) A horse in the furosemide program that competes out-of-state without furosemide as a condition of the race is considered to have been removed from the Texas furosemide program effective the date of its first race without furosemide. (3) Withdrawal from the furosemide program does not prohibit a horse from subsequent readmission to the program in accordance with this section.
- (f) Readmission to the Furosemide Program.**
A horse may be readmitted to the furosemide program if: (1) at least 30 days have elapsed prior to the subsequent day of intended race since the horse was voluntarily withdrawn from the program as described in subsection (e)(1) of this section; (2) the horse is required to compete with furosemide pursuant to subsection (b)(2) of this section; (3) a commission veterinarian, association veterinarian, or practicing veterinarian diagnoses the horse with another EIPH event within 4 hours of official works, recorded timed works, or live race; or (4) at least 14 days have elapsed since the horse competed out of state without furosemide under subsection (e)(2) of this section.
- (g) Bleeders List.** (1) The commission veterinarian shall maintain a list of horses that have been certified as bleeders and a list of horses that have been admitted to the furosemide program. (2) On receipt of a report of a diagnosed EIPH event, the commission veterinarian shall place the horse on the veterinarian's list and the horse shall be ineligible to race for the following time periods: (A) First incident - 14 days; (B) Second incident within 365 days of previous incident - 30 days; (C) Third incident within 365 days of previous incident - 180 days; (D) Fourth incident within 365 days of previous incident - lifetime ban from racing in this state. (3) A horse with fewer than four EIPH events that has not had a diagnosed EIPH event for a period of 365 consecutive days is considered a non-bleeder for purposes of this subsection. The report of a diagnosed EIPH event from any pari-mutuel jurisdiction which officially records EIPH events will be recognized as an EIPH event by the Commission. (4) Notwithstanding the foregoing, if after reviewing a report of a diagnosed EIPH event the commission veterinarian determines additional days on the veterinarian's list are essential to the health and safety of the horse, the commission veterinarian may extend the number of days the horse is on the veterinarian's list. The commission veterinarian shall record the medical reasons for the additional days.
- (h) Report by Veterinarian.** A veterinarian who administers furosemide to a horse that has been admitted to the furosemide program shall report the administration on a form prescribed by the Commission. A report made under this subsection must be filed with the test barn supervisor not later than two hours before post time for the first race of that day. Horses not on the Lasix Report are subject to vet scratch.

PERMISSIBLE MEDICATION LEVELS

In accordance with TXRC Rule Section 319.1(b) and 319.3(b)-(c), the following substances are permissible if found at or below the following specified concentration levels in post-race samples taken from a horse:

Dimethylsulfoxide/DMSO	10 mcg/ml in plasma or serum
Flunixin	5 ng/ml in plasma or serum
Furosemide	100 ng/ml in plasma or serum and urine specific gravity <1.010
Glycopyrrolate	3 pg/ml in plasma or serum
Guaifenesin	12 ng/ml in plasma or serum
Ketoprofen	2 ng/ml in plasma or serum
Lidocaine	20 pg/ml of 30H-lidocaine in plasma or serum

CLAIMING RULES

Sec. 313.301. Eligibility to Claim

- (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section, in a claiming race, each horse is subject to be claimed for its entered price by:
 - (1) a licensed owner or lessee or an authorized agent acting on behalf of the owner or lessee;
 - (2) a person who has applied for an owner's license and has been granted approval by the stewards to make a claim.
- (b) A claim may not be made directly or indirectly by an owner for his or her own horse.
- (c) If the person making a claim is a minor, the claim must be co-signed by a licensed adult parent or guardian of the minor. A parent or guardian who co-signs a claim is liable for the claim. A claim made by a minor that is not co-signed in accordance with this subsection is invalid.

Sec. 313.302. Claim Procedure

- (a) A steward or a designee of the stewards shall supervise the making of claims and ensure the accuracy of all claims made in a race.
- (b) A claim must be made in writing on forms and in envelopes approved by the executive secretary. The form and envelope must be filled out completely and must be accurate in every detail. For purpose of this section, the name of the horse as it appears in the official program governs.
- (c) The person making a claim is responsible for determining the sex of the horse.
- (d) A claim must be time stamped with the official track time shown on the tote board and deposited in a locked box provided by the Racing Secretary not later than 15 minutes before post time of the race in which the horse being claimed is to start. A person may not place money or its equivalent in the claim box.
- (e) Before the deadline for filing claims for a race, a person may not: open the box in which claims are deposited; or reveal information regarding the filing of a claim.
- (f) After the deadline for filing claims for a race, a Steward or a designee of the stewards shall open the box, examine the claims, and notify the stewards of all accurate claims. The stewards or designee will then notify the horsemen's bookkeeper of the claims to determine whether the appropriate amount is on deposit with the bookkeeper in accordance with 313.305 (relating to amounts of deposit) and to debit the claimant's account for the amount of the claim, plus all applicable fees. If more than one person enters a claim for a horse, a steward or a designee of the stewards shall determine the disposition of the horse by lot.

Sec. 313.303. Effective Time of Claim

- (a) A person who has a valid claim to a horse becomes the owner of the horse when the horse steps on to the racetrack for the race. A claim shall be voided and ownership of the horse retained by the original owner if:
 - (1) the horse dies on the racetrack or is euthanized by a Commission Veterinarian before leaving the racetrack, either on the race surface or in the equine ambulance.
 - (2) the horse has a musculoskeletal injury that requires loading in the equine ambulance for safe removal from the track. This claim is only voided after proper Veterinary examination of injury and the on duty Commission Veterinarian is contacted and approves of euthanasia. Horses euthanized without Veterinarian examination and notification to the attending Commission Veterinarian will not be entitled to a voided claim.
- (b) Horses vanned off the track for medical conditions (including but not limited to EIPH, Myositis, heat stress, extreme exhaustion) will not be treated as a voided claim.
- (c) On the day claimed, a claimed horse runs in the interest of and for the account of the owner from whom the horse was claimed.

Sec. 313.304. Claim Irrevocable

- (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section, a claim that is filed in accordance with this subchapter is irrevocable.
- (b) If the stewards declare a claiming race a "no-race", all claims for that race are invalid.

Sec. 313.305. Amounts of Deposit

- (a) To make a valid claim, a person must have on deposit with the horsemen's bookkeeper an amount of the claim, plus all transfer fees, in the form of cash, money order, certified check or cashier's check.
- (b) A person who files a claim may not exhaust the person's account with the association during the two-hour period after the claim was filed.

Sec. 313.306. Transfer of Claimed Horse

- (a) A horse that has been claimed in a claiming race shall be taken after the race to the area designated by the association for delivery to the claimant, unless the horse is designated for testing.
- (b) A person may not refuse to deliver a claimed horse.
- (c) The engagements of a claimed horse automatically transfer to the new owner. A claimed horse is ineligible for entry in a future race unless the entry is made on behalf of the new owner.
- (d) A horse may not be delivered to a successful claimant without authorization from a steward or a designee of the stewards.

Sec. 313.307. Responsibility of Testing

The trainer losing a horse through a claim is nevertheless responsible for the results of any drug tests performed on specimens obtained from the horse. The trainer is responsible for the horse during the testing procedures and may not deliver the horse to the successful claimant in the test barn until the commission veterinarian informs the trainer or representative that all testing procedures are complete.

Sec. 313.308. Restrictions on Subsequent Use

- (a) A horse claimed in a claiming race in Texas:
 - (1) may not be sold or transferred in whole or part, by any method other than a claiming race during the 30-day period after the initial claim;
 - (2) and is ineligible to start in a race at a race meeting other than the one at which it was claimed until the end of the meeting at which the horse was claimed, except in a stakes race after verification by the board of stewards.
- (b) A horse claimed in another state is subject to the eligibility requirements for claimed horses in effect at the time of the claim in the jurisdiction in which the horse was claimed.

PONY PERSONS

Pony persons taking horses to the post must wear a Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie shirt, jacket and helmet cover. The required items are available for purchase in the Jockey's Room. All pony people are required to wear a safety helmet and follow the posted policies and procedures statement.

GROOM'S ATTIRE

All grooms should be neatly dressed and wear a numbered vest when taking horses to the paddock.

In consideration of the acceptance of an entry of any horse to any race described in this Condition Book, the owner(s) and trainer of such horse consent to the collection of information related to any equine injury occurring at the Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie facility to such horse and entry of said information into a database maintained by The Jockey Club (the "Equine Injury Database"). Said owner(s) and trainer further agree to indemnify, release, hold harmless and covenant not to sue Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie, any state or track appointed veterinarian collecting such information and The Jockey Club (collectively, the "Indemnified Parties") from and against any liability, cost, loss, or expense of any kind or nature (including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees) arising from any claim, demand, or action (a) alleging that the data entered into the Equine Injury Database (either directly or indirectly) violates the rights of the owner(s), trainer or third party, or (b) relating to any equine injury report run, published or otherwise created by any of the Indemnified Parties, including the owners, stewards, directors, officers, employees and agents of any of them (either directly or indirectly).

LIABILITY NOTICE

In participating at Lone Star Park, applicant recognizes the risks of the activities to be conducted at the Racetrack by or on behalf of applicant, the owners of the horses named in this application and all other persons for whom applicant is acting (applicant and such owners and other persons are collectively referred to as "indemnifying parties"), and has determined that the facilities at the Racetrack are reasonably suited for all horse racing related activities to be conducted by or on behalf of any such parties. Lone Star Park (and its partners, officers, directors, agents, vendors, employees, contractors, visitors and licensees collectively "Lone Star") shall not be liable to any of the indemnifying parties or any of their employees, agents, invitees or visitors, or to any other person whomsoever, for any injury to persons or damage to property on the Racetrack premises or any adjacent area caused by the negligence or misconduct of any of the indemnifying parties, their employees, agents, invitees, visitors or any other person entering the Racetrack premises under express or implied invitation of any of the indemnifying parties. The indemnifying parties hereby agree to release Lone Star from and to indemnify and hold Lone Star harmless from any liability, loss, expense or claims (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising out of such injury or damage. The indemnifying parties shall not be liable to Lone Star or to any other person whomsoever entering the Racetrack premises under express or implied invitation of Lone Star, for any injury to persons or damage to property on the Racetrack premises or any adjacent area caused by the negligence or misconduct of Lone Star, and Lone Star agrees to release the indemnifying parties from and to indemnify and hold the indemnifying parties harmless from any liability, loss, expense or claims (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising out of any such injury or damage. In the event of any inconsistency between these provisions and any mandatory provisions of the Texas Racing Act or Rules of Racing, the Texas Racing Act or Rules of Racing, as applicable, shall control. Further, these provisions shall be deemed to be amended to the extent of, and to be in compliance with, any mandatory provisions of any amendment to the Texas Racing Act or Rules of Racing. The foregoing release and indemnification provisions shall be construed in a manner consistent with the limitations set forth herein to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Texas.

TURF COURSE

TATTOOING & DIGITAL CERTIFICATES

All horses must be tattooed to be eligible to start.

DIGITAL TATTOOING PROCEDURES

A Thoroughbred making its first lifetime start requires a TRPB Digital Tattoo.

The TRPB Technician will scan the microchip to access the digital copy of the foal certificate, validate the information, verify the markings, color and gender, then take 10 -14 photos of the horse to digitally document all equine attributes. Bandages, poultice, blankets must be off the horse and the horse must be named by the time the TRPB Technician is present to digitally tattoo each horse.

Lone Star Park TRPB Technician is Juan Ortega. His contact is 682-478-6271 to schedule an appointment.

The cost to have your horse TRPB VERIFIED is \$115 for each horse and must be paid before TRPB technician digitally tattoos your horse. Payment can be made by Credit Card, Apple Pay or Google Pay.

HELMET AND SAFETY VEST

All jockeys and exercise people must wear both an approved helmet and safety vest while mounted on a horse. Approved helmets and safety vests are also required for all pony persons. The outriders will enforce this rule for your safety.

OWNER'S SILKS & FOAL PAPERS

All owners must furnish their own colors. Following the conclusion of the meet please arrange for your silks and foal papers to be picked up. Although Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie makes every effort to insure the safety of both, we will not be held responsible for either silks or foal papers left later than one week after the final day of the meet.
